Conjunctions are words used to join sentences together .

For example : Lepidina was cross. Minimus was eating the cheese on the table.

Lepidina was cross **because** Minimus was eating the cheese on the table.

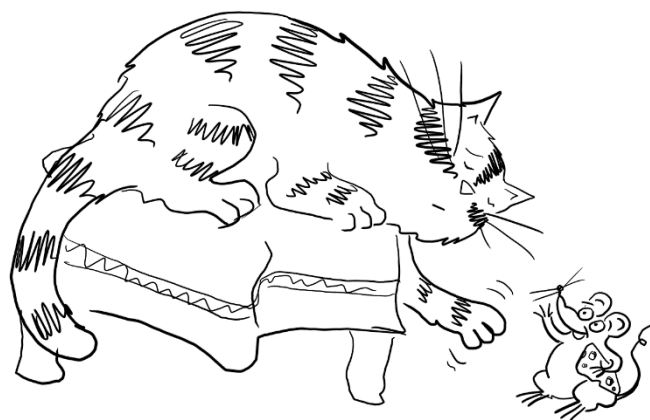
6	The standard-bearer carries the standard into battle.
