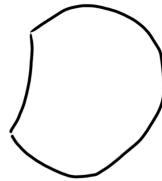
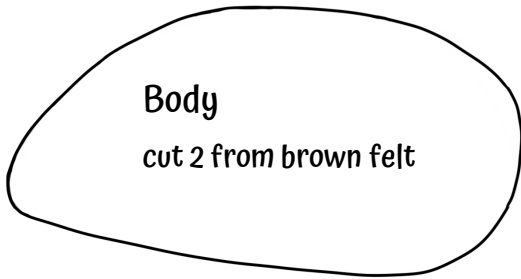




Minimus and Cheese Decorations

What you need:

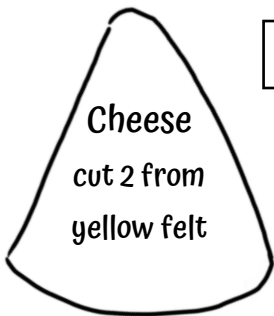
- Brown, yellow and a little bit of white felt
- Brown and yellow embroidery thread
- White sewing cotton
- 2 tiny black beads
- 2 pieces of ribbon, about 12 cm each
- Stuffing - cotton wool is fine



Eye
cut 2 from white felt



Pattern pieces



Cheese edge cut 1 from yellow felt

What to do: Mouse

Cut the pieces out.

Plait a length of embroidery thread, knot it at both ends leaving a tail about 6cm long. Sandwich the tail between front and back, so it is sewn into place. Sew the mouse body pieces together round the outside, leaving a space from A to B. Use a simple whip stitch or blanket stitch. Stuff the mouse, sew in the ribbon and sew up the open bit.

Sew the ears on after the mouse is stuffed. Sew the eyes on, and then sew the little black beads on as pupils.

What to do: Cheese

Sew one side to the long strip all the way round, and sew the other to the long strip 2/3 of the way round. Stuff the cheese through the opening, sew in the ribbon loop and sew the opening closed.
